

FIVE STEPS TO STOVE HEAVEN THIS AUTUMN

With the colder months nearly upon us, it's time to start thinking about how to heat your home this winter

Planning ahead for a new stove can seem like a complicated business at times. So the helpful team at Pinckney Green have come up with some useful questions to ask before choosing the right wood burning or multi-fuel stove for your home.

Preferred style – contemporary or traditional?

For contemporary stove styles, try Charnwood or morso.co.uk and for a traditional look try Chesney's or Stovax.

Stove position – on a hearth or set inside the chimney breast?

Measure what size hearth stone will be needed to support your stove. Or assess the cost of removing the existing fire and extending the chamber opening.

What heat output does your room need?

Know your room size to work out what kilowatt of heat output your stove should produce.

Wood burning or multi-fuel stove?

Wood burning stoves are cheaper and have bigger viewing windows whereas multi-fuel stoves offer the flexibility of using coal or wood.

Chimney services and safety certification?

Research what chimney services you'll need, for example, chimney sweeping, smoke tests or flue liner installation. Finally, check your stove installer is HETAS registered and offers safety certificates.
